


CURRENT STATUS:



Faith did not receive partial government sponsorship through the Higher Education Loans Board (HELB) since priority is given to university students. Her elder sister graduated last year from university and her younger brother is a Form 3 high school student. All the three siblings depend on well wishers to support their education. Faith's desire is to attain economic independence and better the lot of her family and community at large. Her KNEC results will be out at the end of August, 2025 and thereafter she will embark on a paid internship at Yala Sub-County Hospital situated in the community where she was brought up.


