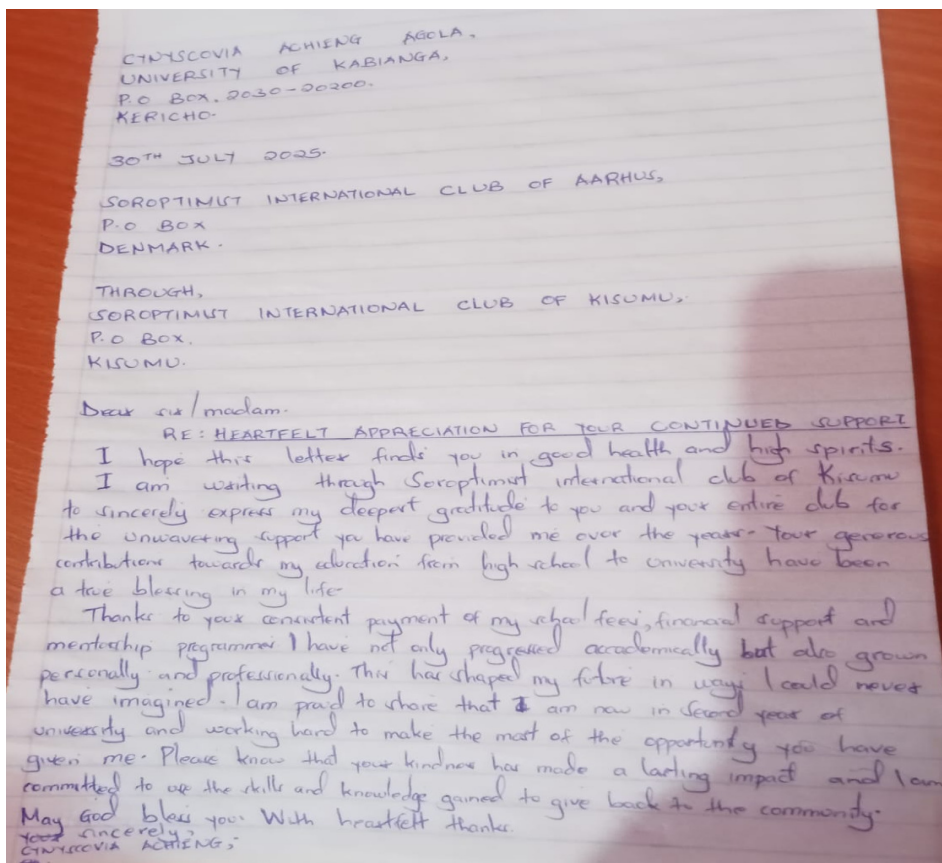

This was followed by a **4-month** one on one virtual **leadership coaching session** until December, 2023 and **graduation** in **January, 2024**. **Women Leading Change (WLC) Program** is a **transformational leadership program** for East African women who aspire to positions of increasing responsibility and impact in their organizations and communities. The unique approach combines best practices in building new skills and shifting into more empowering mindsets. Graduates report powerful transformations within themselves resulting in improved relationships, increased leadership impact, increased confidence and progress toward overarching life goals. The knowledge and skills gained have contributed immensely to Rose's role as a **Young Soroptimist** and a powerful peer **mentor** in the **SI Club of Kisumu Mentorship and Leadership Programme**.

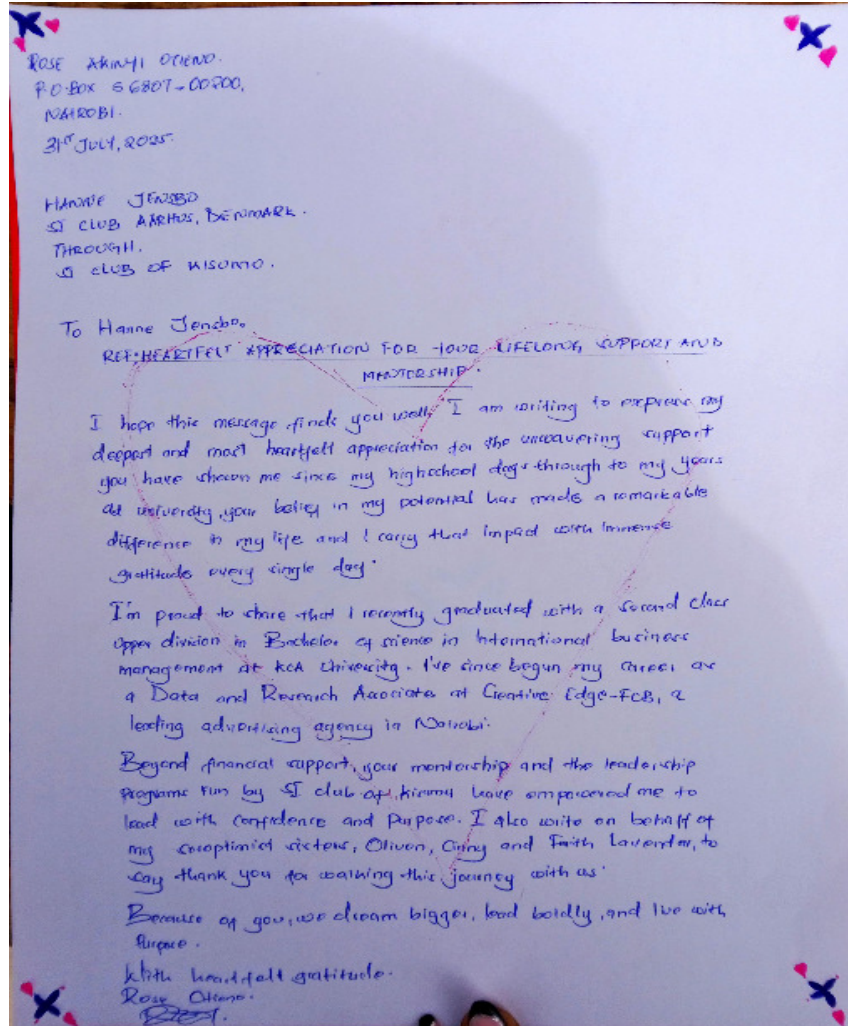
